Public Portion

There being no comment the public portion was closed.

Minutes

Minutes of the July 21, 2020 meeting were approved on a motion by Mr. Rowand, seconded by Mr. Stemberger.

Engineer's Report

There was a sewer backup at 69 Marlton Road due to tree roots and infiltration. A motion was made by Mr. Stemberger, seconded by Mr. Layton authorizing up to \$4,000.00 for root cutting and video of Marlton Road.

Video has been done for East Grant but Mr. Biermann needs the map of the lines in order to review. He said there is a lot of roots.

The Rt. 40 paving should be completed before school starts.

The Borough has applied for a grant for East Grant Street.

Pierson still has bonds and submittals before work can begin on Dickinson. Mr. Biermann would also like for the Route 40 work to be completed.

A resident on Richman has had a problem with her sewer lateral caused by SJ Gas work last year. It appears that SJ Gas is addressing the issue.

Treasurer's Report

The only item is the grease trap ordinance

Wastewater Report

The recent heavy rains flooded the plant.

The verbatim dialer is installed and is working as well as the County's flow meter.
