**Public Portion**

There being no comment the public portion was closed.

**Minutes**

Minutes of the September 15, 2020 meeting were approved on a motion by Mr. Hathaway, seconded by Mr. Rowand.

**Engineer's Report**

RESOLUTION 2020-20

Awarding a contract for Collection System Investigation Phase I to Equix Integrity, Inc. in the amount of \$\$186,012.75 was moved by Mr. Stemberger, seconded by Mr. Layton and a unanimous roll call vote.

32 Ashbrooke Avenue sewer lateral collapsed. It ran behind the property to West Millbrooke and was also shared with another property. A motion was made by Mr. Stemberger, seconded by Mr. Layton approving the new connection off of Mill Street.

South State is working on the punch list for Rt. 40.

The sewer break at 53 West Avenue has been repaired. The driveway and road still need to be completed.

Work will begin tomorrow on a punch list for Route 40 to 77.

**Treasurer's Report**

The monthly reports and cash position were reviewed.

The separate sewer billing software has been installed and operational effective October 1.

**Solicitor's Report**

Mrs. Gaglione has started preparing a letter to be sent to businesses affected by the new grease trap ordinance.

The Solicitor will send a letter to DOT informing them of potential sewer issues from the work on West Avenue.

**Wastewater Report**

The nitrates are still running very low.

Airlifts 1 & 3 have been replaced. #2 is still malfunctioning.

Video Pipe cut roots and jetted on Grandview which caused a backup in someone's house so they abandoned the project.

Additional UV modules have been sent out to be refurbished.

The Public Works Superintendent informed a resident that the Borough could not dig a sewer lateral. The Solicitor was asked to review the street opening ordinance to determine if this is addressed.
