Public Portion

Minutes

Engineer's Report

The Route 40 punch list is ongoing.

Pierson is scheduled to install the liner on Dickinson on December 2. They still need approval from the County for the railroad and the detour plan has to be approved by the state.

Video Pipe jetter caused a backup into a home which the homeowner ended up cleaning. A policy should be in place for these instances. It will be included in future projects that the contractor should have a plan in place or have Serv Pro clean it up.

As builts are still needed for the Liberty/Spring Garden project.

Contracts for the collection system have been sent out to Equix.

30 Dickinson reported a sewer issue due to gas company work. SJ gas dug it up but it was fine. There should be a policy in place that if the main is clear the homeowner should be instructed to contact a plumber.

Treasurer's Report

The monthly reports and cash position were reviewed.

Interest rate on the bank account has plummeted from 0.35% to 0.05%. The Treasurer would like to look into rates at Pennsville National Bank.

Wastewater Report

A motion was made by Mr. Layton, seconded by Mr. Rowand to purchase 3 airlift filters at a cost not to exceed \$17,408.08.
