**WOODSTOWN BOROUGH HALL SERVICES
TO BE PROVIDED TO THE PUBLIC PRIMARILY BY PHONE AND EMAIL
DURING THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC.**

Governor Murphy has declared a state of emergency in New Jersey. During the next few weeks, while the state of emergency is in effect, the health of residents and employees will be better protected by reducing as much as possible physical interaction between residents and office workers. The health of our residents and employees is our first priority.

To reduce risk of the coronavirus spreading in Woodstown, Borough Council has voted to **restrict access to Borough Hall and the Police Station** by the general public during New Jersey's state of emergency. The Borough will provide services primarily by phone and email instead of in-person, as we would normally do.

Please drop off mail that includes payments for dog licenses or other payments at the mailbox installed in back of Borough Hall. Late fees for dog licenses are being waived during 2020. Dog tags for 2020 will be mailed to you.

For the Woodstown Police Department please call 856-769-1330. An officer will come see you if you wish.

For all ambulance and police and fire emergencies please call 9-1-1.

For an appointment to meet with the **Planning Board** please call Melissa Fackler at 856-769-2200 ext.10

If your request requires meeting in-person the appropriate borough professional or police office will schedule an in-person meeting with you. A drop-box has been installed at the back door of borough hall to receive tax, sewer and water payments if you wish to stop by. Of course you can also mail your payments to 25 West Ave Woodstown NJ 0098. Taxes/Water/Sewer can be paid online using the link provided on the borough website <https://historicwoodstown.org>.

Public access to the Sewer Plant is prohibited during the coronavirus epidemic until the state of emergency has been lifted by Governor Murphy. The playground equipment at Marvin L. Watson Memorial Park is closed per our Governor's order.

Meetings of Borough Council and the Sewerage Authority will take place at least during March via conference call. The decision to continue using conference call meetings will be made as events unfold. The public is welcome to attend by listening in during the conference call.
